**4. Title:** Public release of student directory information.

**5. Summary:** Provides that directory information as defined by the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act may be released publicly if the school or institution of higher education has notified the student, or legal guardian if the student is under 18, of the type of information to be released, the right of the student or guardian to refuse release of this information, and the period of time during which the student or guardian can provide written notification that he or she does not want any or all information released. Further provides that address, phone number, and email address may not be released unless the student or guardian provides written consent.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Final. See Item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The bill delineates the way in which certain student directory information can be released. No fiscal impact is anticipated.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** Local school divisions, institutions of higher education.
