**4. Title:** Parked vehicles; registration, licensing, and titling requirements.

**5. Summary:** This bill expands from vehicles operated on a highway to vehicles operated or parked on a highway the class of vehicles subject to registration, licensing, and titling requirements. The bill contains technical amendments.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Indeterminate. See Item #8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** The number of vehicles impacted by this legislation cannot be determined. Any vehicle falling into this category would be required to pay the applicable motor vehicle registration fee. For a standard passenger vehicle, the fee is \$40.75 and is divided between the Virginia Department of Transportation (\$29), Virginia State Police (\$1.50), Department of Health (\$6.25) and Department of Motor Vehicles (\$4).
