4. Title: Certain fraud crimes; multi-jurisdiction grand jury; Virginia Consumer Protection Act.

Summary: Adds the offenses of obtaining money by false pretense, financial exploitation of mentally incapacitated persons, and construction fraud to the criminal violations that a multi-jurisdiction grand jury may investigate and to prohibited practices under the Virginia Consumer Protection Act (§ 59.1-196et seq.).
