4. Title: Transmission of electronic case papers between district and circuit courts

5. Summary: The proposed bill establishes that when case papers are transmitted between the district and circuit courts and there is an agreement between the chief judge of the applicable district court and the clerk of the circuit court for the electronic transmission of case papers, the case papers shall be transmitted between the courts by an electronic method approved by the Executive Secretary of the Supreme Court, with the exception of any exhibit that cannot be electronically transmitted.

This bill also permits the clerk in the appellate court to request that any paper trial records be forwarded to such clerk.
