5. Summary: Requires local departments of social services to notify the Superintendent of Public Instruction without delay when an individual holding a license issued by the Board of Education is the subject of a founded complaint of child abuse or neglect.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill does not have a fiscal impact, as the legislation only changes the timing of the notification from the local department of social services. The engrossed bill requires the Department to notify the Superintendent without delay if the founded complaint is dismissed.
