Summary: This bill requires the governing board of each public institution of higher education to implement guidelines for the adoption and use of low-cost and no-cost open educational resources in offered courses. The guidelines may include stipulations for low-cost commercially published materials.

8. Fiscal Implications: The number of faculty members of Virginia's public institutions of higher education that would embrace the use of open educational resources and low-cost commercially published materials is unknown. However, such materials could reduce textbook costs for students.
