Summary:** This bill permits operators of bed and breakfast establishments, defined in the bill, to sell or offer for sale transportation for compensation without first obtaining a broker's license issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles or a transportation network company broker's license, provided that their broker service is provided only to guests of such bed and breakfast establishment.
