Summary:** Requires the Virginia Conflict of Interest and Ethics Advisory Council (the Council) to conduct an annual inspection of a random sample of disclosure statements filed with the Council to determine compliance with applicable disclosure requirements and limitations on gifts, the accuracy of information disclosed, and whether filing deadlines were met. The bill requires the random sampling to include the disclosure forms of (i) one member of the House of Delegates and one Senator and (ii) one percent of all state officers

and employees and one percent of all lobbyists who file such forms.
