5. Summary: ; Zoning violation penalties. Increases the maximum fine for misdemeanor conviction of a zoning violation from \$1,000 to \$2,500. The bill also increases the maximum fine for failure to remove or abate the zoning violation after conviction from \$1,500 to \$2,500 for succeeding 10-day periods.
