3. Committee: General Laws

4. Title: Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation; contractors; prohibited acts.

5. Summary: Provides that a contract entered into by a person undertaking work without a valid Virginia contractor's license is unenforceable by such person. However, the bill also prohibits assertion of lack of licensure or certification as a defense to any action or suit if the unlicensed contractor gives substantial performance within the terms of the contract in good faith and without actual knowledge that a license or certificate was required.
