- **4. Title:** Adultery; civil penalty.
- **5. Summary:** Reduces the penalty for adultery from a Class 4 misdemeanor to a civil penalty of not more than \$250.
- 6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No
- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item 8 below.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: Currently, a Class 4 misdemeanor is punishable with a fine of up to \$250, which is deposited into the Literary Fund. This bill removes the criminal penalty of a Class 4 misdemeanor but assesses a civil penalty for adultery, also punishable with no more than \$250 to be deposited into the Literary Fund. Therefore, there is no fiscal impact that results from changing the penalty from a criminal offense to a civil offense in this case.
