4. Title: Virginia Public Procurement Act; cooperative procurement; construction.

5. Summary: Allows public bodies to utilize cooperative procurement for (i) public utility and infrastructure projects and (ii) the demolition of buildings, where the expected cost is less than \$500,000.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: No state fiscal impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill is permissive and is not expected to have a state fiscal impact.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: All public bodies subject to the Virginia Public Procurement Act (VPPA) except for higher education institutions operating under Management Agreements or Memoranda of Understanding in the operational area of procurement and local governments who have exempted themselves from the VPPA.
