4. Title: State and Local Government Conflict of Interests Act; disclosure statements; multiple positions.

5. Summary: The substitute bill changes the filing requirements such that a filing of a single current statement of economic interests by an individual will suffice for the course of a calendar year. The substitute bill provides that any individual who has met the requirement for filing a annual disclosure statement will not be required to file an additional disclosure statement upon reappointment to the same office or position, if the reappointment occurs within 12 months of the filing; currently, certain officers and employees reappointed to the same office or position must file new disclosure statements if the reappointment occurs more than six months after the filing.
