8. Fiscal Implications: This bill would require an update to the Virginia Election and Registration Information System (VERIS) to establish a new reason code (category) to identify voters who vote in-person by absentee ballot without providing another existing reason for being unable to vote in-person on election day. The agency would also have to update absentee forms, reports, and other VERIS functionality to accommodate the modified reason code. The Department of Elections (ELECT) estimates the cost of these updates to be \$4,700: \$2,500 for changes to VERIS and \$2,200 for changes to forms, web materials, and guidance documents.

As stand-alone legislation, ELECT considers implementation of this bill as "routine," and does not require significant additional funding. However, the Department of Elections will review all electoral legislation likely to be enacted prior to the passage by each house. If the aggregate number of "routine" bills likely to pass either house is unusually large, it is possible that the Department of Elections will require additional resources. If so, the Department of Elections will identify the costs at that time.
