4. Title: Driving under the influence.

5. Summary: Makes the provisions of § 18.2-266, concerning driving under the influence, and § 18.2-266.1, concerning driving after illegally consuming alcohol by persons under 21, not applicable to any person driving or operating a motor vehicle on his own residential property or the curtilage thereof. The current law prohibits driving a vehicle under the influence in all situations.
