3. Committee: Education and Health

4. Title: School boards; employment of certain individuals.

5. Summary: Prohibits any school board from employing (i) any individual who has been convicted of any felony offense against a child; a certain act of violence or violent felony; or any offense involving the sexual molestation, physical or sexual abuse, or rape of a child or (ii) any other individual who has been convicted of any other felony offense unless such individual has had his civil rights restored by the Governor and at least 5 years have passed since such conviction.

8. Fiscal Implications: There is no anticipated state fiscal impact resulting from the provisions of this bill. Any fiscal impact to localities is indeterminate.
