4. Title: Child-caring institutions.

5. Summary: Provides that a child-caring institution (i) operated or conducted under the auspices of a religious institution established in 1978, (ii) located in Atkins, Virginia, at the intersection of Pierce Road and Freedom Tabernacle Lane, and (iii) granted licensure as a child-caring institution after January 1, 1987, that receives no public funds shall be licensed under minimum standards for licensed child-caring institutions as adopted by the Board of Social Services and in effect on January 1, 1987.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill does not have a fiscal impact. The legislation would allow any children's residential facility, operated as a religious institution, located at a specified location in Atkins, Virginia, to be exempt from being licensed under the regulations for children's residential facilities.

According to the Department of Social Services (DSS), the provisions of this legislation will expand neither the Department's legal authority nor service population. DSS is aware of only one specific facility to be licensed based on the provisions of this legislation and, therefore, any increased workload from the passage of this bill can be absorbed with the agency's current appropriation and staffing levels.
