5.	Summary: This bill requires the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV), through the Virginia Longitudinal Data System, to report additional information regarding the alignment of postsecondary education and workforce preparation in the Commonwealth. This bill also directs the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV), Virginia Employment Commission (VEC), and Department of Taxation (TAX) to cooperate with SCHEV in determining the feasibility of entering into data-sharing and data-collecting agreements.
6.	Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
7.	Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final (see Section 8)
8.	Fiscal Implications: This legislation does not have a fiscal impact on SCHEV, DMV, and TAX. Currently, VEC does not collect information on hours worked from employers and has no mechanism to do so. The United States Department of Labor informed VEC that it could not alter any of the forms to collect the bill's required information because such data is not necessary to administer the unemployment compensation program. Therefore, the hours worked data hoped for from this legislation would more than likely not be available.
