The cost of the FLEX transponders (used on Virginia High Occupancy Toll (HOT) or Express Lanes) are twice as much as the standard transponders; it is cost effective to deter patrons who do not use the Flex functionality from keeping FLEX transponders on their EZ Pass account.
