**3. Committee:** Privileges and Elections

**4. Title:** Campaign finance; with whom former candidates file reports.

**5. Summary:** Requires a former candidate who is no longer seeking election but has not yet filed a final report as required by law and who files reports in nonelectronic format to file with the general registrar of the locality in which he sought office. In the case of a former candidate who is no longer seeking election but has not yet filed a final report as required by law and who files reports electronically, the State Board is required to promptly notify the general registrar of the locality in which the candidate sought office and to make the information contained in the report available to such general registrar.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** As stand-alone legislation, ELECT considers implementation of this bill as “routine,” and does not require additional funding. However, the agency will review all electoral legislation likely to be enacted prior to the passage by each house. If the aggregate number of “routine” bills likely to pass either house is unusually large, it is possible the agency will require additional resources. If so, ELECT will identify the costs at that time.
