2. Patron: Sturtevant

3. Committee: Passed Both Houses

4. Title: Public institutions of higher education; guaranteed admissions agreements.

5. Summary: Provides that the guaranteed admissions agreements between baccalaureate public institutions of higher education and associate-degree-granting public institutions of higher education may provide for the guaranteed admission of a student who earns an associate degree concurrently with a high school diploma through a dual enrollment program, as well as any student who earns an associate degree after high school.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: As written this bill allows, but does not require, existing guaranteed admissions agreements to include students in dual enrollment programs. There is no anticipated fiscal impact associated with this change.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Four-year institutions of higher education, Virginia Community College System, Richard Bland College.

10. Technical Amendment Necessary: No.

11. Other Comments: Current law does not prohibit four-year institutions from including dual enrollment students in guaranteed admissions agreements.
