3. Committee: Senate Committee on Rehabilitation and Social Services

4. Title: Donations of beer by brewery licensees

5. Summary: Provides that any brewery licensee may donate beer that it has manufactured and any (i) mixed beverage special events licensee or (ii) banquet licensee that is a charitable nonprofit corporation or association that is exempt from taxation under Â§ 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code may accept and serve such beer for on-premises consumption at the licensed charitable special event. The bill also permits brewery licensees to sponsor charitable events.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary (see Item #8)

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC), this bill will have a minimal fiscal impact. Current ABC regulation 3 VAC 5-20-100 permits breweries to sponsor charitable events.
