4. Title: Special license plates; emergency medical services agencies; fire departments

5. Summary: This bill requires emergency medical services agencies or volunteer emergency medical services agency auxiliaries to notify the Commissioner of the Department of Motor Vehicles within 30 days of separation of any member from such agency or agency auxiliary. The bill requires fire departments to maintain a copy of an approved application for a special license plate for professional or volunteer fire fighters and members of volunteer fire department auxiliaries and to notify the Commissioner within 30 days of separation of any professional fire fighter, volunteer fire fighter, or member of volunteer fire department auxiliary, from such fire department. The notification is to include the former member's date of birth, credential customer number or license plate number.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: None.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Final. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: As written, the bill does not require the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to make information systems programming changes that would result in a fiscal impact. However, the bill does prompt DMV to conduct a manual review of the applicant lists received from these entities. DMV expects to experience an indeterminate impact on current staff hours due to the unknown number of requests that may be received.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Motor Vehicles, fire departments, volunteer fire departments, fire departments auxiliaries, emergency medical services agencies, volunteer emergency medical services agency auxiliaries.
