WHEREAS, Andy Jacks is active with the Virginia Association of Elementary School Principals and the National Association of Elementary School Principals, and he serves as director at large and a board member of the Autism Society of Northern Virginia; and

WHEREAS, Andy Jacks' well-deserved honor was the second consecutive National Distinguished Principal Award for a Prince William County Public Schools administrator, a mark of the high caliber of educators in the school system and the amazing dedication they have for their students; now, therefore, be it
