14	§ 2.2-3715. Effect of advisory opinions from the Freedom of Information Advisory Council on
15	liability for willful and knowing violations.
16	Any officer, employee, or member of a public body who is alleged to have committed a willful and
17	knowing violation pursuant to § 2.2-3714 shall have the right to introduce at any proceeding a copy of
18	a relevant advisory opinion issued pursuant to § 30-179 as evidence that he did not willfully and
19	knowingly commit the violation if the alleged violation resulted from his good faith reliance on the
20	advisory opinion.
2 1	§ 30-179. Powers and duties of the Council.
22	The Council shall:
23	1. Furnish, upon request, advisory opinions or guidelines, and other appropriate information regarding
24	the Freedom of Information Act (§ 2.2-3700 et seq.) to any person or agency of state or local
25	government public body, in an expeditious manner;
26	2. Conduct training seminars and educational programs for the members and staff of public bodies
27	and other interested persons on the requirements of the Freedom of Information Act (§ 2.2-3700 et seq.);
28	3. Publish such educational materials as it deems appropriate on the provisions of the Freedom of
29	Information Act (§ 2.2-3700 et seq.);
30	4. Request from any agency of state or local government public body such assistance, services, and
31	information as will enable the Council to effectively carry out its responsibilities. Information provided
32	to the Council by an agency of state or local government a public body shall not be released to any
33	other party unless authorized by such agency public body;
34	5. Assist in the development and implementation of the provisions of § 2.2-3704.1;
35	6. Develop the public comment form for use by designated public bodies in accordance with
36	subdivision D 6 of § 2.2-3708.2;
37	7. Develop an online public comment form to be posted on the Council's official public government
38	website to enable any requester to comment on the quality of assistance provided to the requester by a

40	8. Report annually on or before December 1 of each year on its activities and findings regarding the
