6	A BILL to require the Director of the Department of Corrections to review and revise the Department's
7	visitation policies concerning visitors at state correctional facilities; wearing of tampons or
8	menstrual cups.
9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. § 1. The Department of Corrections shall adopt a policy regarding visitors who may be menstruating
11	at the time of their visit to state correctional facilities. The policy shall include (i) a process to notify
12	such a visitor of the Department's policy in advance of the visit; (ii) an option for the visitor to remove
13	any tampon or menstrual cup and replace it with a state-issued product in order to complete a contact
14	visit; and (iii) an option for a visitor who refuses to remove any tampon or menstrual cup to complete a
15	non-contact visit. The Department shall make the policy available to the public as soon as practicable
16	and shall provide a copy to the Chairmen of the House Committee on Militia, Police and Public Safety
