6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 17.1-606 of the Code of Virginia, relating to civil actions;
7	determination of indigency.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 17.1-606 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 17.1-606. Persons allowed services without fees or costs.
11	A. Any person who is (i) a plaintiff in a civil action in a court of the Commonwealth and a resident
12	of the Commonwealth or (ii) a defendant in a civil action in a court of the Commonwealth, and who is
13	on account of his poverty unable to pay fees or costs, may be allowed by a court to sue or defend a suit
14	therein, without paying fees or costs; whereupon he shall have, from any counsel whom the court may
15	assign him, and from all officers, all needful services and process, without any fees, except what may be
16	included in the costs recovered from the opposite party.
17	B. In determining a person's inability to pay fees or costs on account of his poverty, the court shall
18	consider the factors set forth in subsection B of § 19.2-159, provided that, in the case of a no-fault
19	divorce proceeding under subdivision A (9) of § 20-91, there shall be a presumption that a person who
