6	A BILL to amend and reenact § 18.2-461 of the Code of Virginia, relating to false information and hoax
7	criminal activities; penalty.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That § 18.2-461 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
10	§ 18.2-461. Falsely summoning or giving false reports to law-enforcement officials.
11	It shall be unlawful for any person (i) to knowingly give a false report as to the commission of any
12	crime to any law-enforcement official with intent to mislead; (ii) to knowingly, with the intent to
13	mislead a law-enforcement agency, cause another to give a false report to any law-enforcement official
14	by publicly simulating a violation of Chapter 4 (§ 18.2-30 et seq.) or Chapter 5 (§ 18.2-77 et seq.); or
15	(ii) (iii) without just cause and with intent to interfere with the operations of any law-enforcement
16	official, to call or summon any law-enforcement official by telephone or other means, including
17	engagement or activation of an automatic emergency alarm. Violation of the provisions of this section
18	shall be punishable as a Class 1 misdemeanor
