That § 23.1-1308 of the Code of Virgina is amended and reenacted as follows: § 23.1-1308. Governing board procedures; textbook sales and bookstores; open educational resource. A. No employee of a public institution of higher education shall demand or receive any payment, on any ding, present or promised, as an inducement for requiring students to purchase a specific textbook required for coursework or instruction. However, such employee may receive (i) sample copies, instructors copies, or instructional material not to be sold and (ii) royalies or other compensation from sales of textbooks that include such instructors of the books on writing or work. B. The governing board of each public institution of higher education shall implement procedures for making available to students in a central location and in a standard format on the relevant institutional vebsite listings of textbooks for each particular courses at the institution.
