14		§ 23.1-3200.1. Disabled Veteran's State Museum Passport established; free entry into state
15	m	useums and other cultural institutions.
16		The Department of Veterans Services shall establish a Disabled Veteran's State Museum Passport
17	th	at entitles the bearer to enter state museums and other cultural institutions established pursuant to this
18	cł	napter without the payment of a parking or admission fee. The passport shall be issued upon request to
19	a	veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States, or a reserve component thereof, including the
