That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-119.2 as follows: 10 § 18.2-119.2. Prohibited solicitation; penalty; exceptions. 11 12 A. As used in this section: 13 "Dwelling unit" means the same as that term is defined in § 55-248.4. 14 "Established business relationship" means a relationship between the solicited person and the person 15 on whose behalf the home solicitation is being made based on (i) the solicited person's purchase from, or transaction with, the person on whose behalf the home solicitation is being made within the 18 16 months immediately preceding the date of the home solicitation or (ii) the solicited person's inquiry or 17 application regarding any property, good, or service offered by the person on whose behalf the home 18 19 solicitation is being made within the three months immediately preceding the date of the home 20 solicitation. 21 "Home solicitation sale" means the same as that term is defined in § 59.1-21.2. 22 "No soliciting sign" means a sign, display, message, poster, placard, or any other thing that is 23 designed, intended, or used to inform and that displays the words "No Soliciting" or "No Solicitation" 24 printed in a clear and legible size and typeface. 25 "Personal relationship" means the relationship between the person on whose behalf the home 26 solicitation is being made or the person acting for him and any family member, friend, or acquaintance 27 of such person. B. No seller or person acting for him shall make or attempt to make a home solicitation sale (i) to 28 any person on property where he knows or reasonably should know that such person resides in a 29 30 dwelling unit and where there is a no soliciting sign posted at a place where it may be reasonably seen 31 or (ii) to any person who has informed such seller or person acting for him that he does not wish to 32 receive a home solicitation. 33 C. The provisions of this section shall not include a home solicitation of any person (i) with that 34 person's prior express invitation or permission as evidenced by a signed agreement stating that the 35 person agrees to be contacted by or on behalf of a specific party and including the legal address to 36 which the home solicitation may be made; (ii) with whom the person on whose behalf the home 37 solicitation is made has an established business relationship; or (iii) with whom the seller making the 38 home solicitation has a personal relationship. The exemption for an established business relationship or 39 a personal relationship shall not apply when the person solicited has stated previously to the seller or 40 person acting for him that he does not wish to receive a home solicitation. 41 D. Any seller or person acting for him who knowingly violates the provisions of this section is guilty 42 of a Class 1 misdemeanor. E. Each violation of this section shall constitute a separate and distinct offense. The provisions of 43 44 this section shall not preclude prosecution under any other statute.
