3	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Chapter 24 of Title 2.2 an article numbered 27,
4	consisting of sections numbered 2.2-2491 through 2.2-2495, relating to the Virginia African
5	American Advisory Board; report.
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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Chapter 24 of Title 2.2 an article numbered
12	27, consisting of sections numbered 2.2-2491 through 2.2-2495, as follows:
13	Article 27.
14	Virginia African American Advisory Board.
15	§ 2.2-2491. The Virginia African American Advisory Board.
16	The Virginia African American Advisory Board (the Board) is established as an advisory board in
17	the executive branch of state government.
18	§ 2.2-2492. Membership; terms; quorum; meetings.
19	A. The Board shall have a total membership of [27 26] members that shall consist of 21
20	nonlegislative citizen members and [six five] ex officio members. Nonlegislative citizen members shall
21	be appointed as follows: 21 members, at least 15 of whom shall be African American, to be appointed
22	by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the General Assembly. The Secretaries of the
23	Commonwealth, Commerce and Trade, Education, Health and Human Resources, [and] Public Safety [
24	,] and [Transportation, Homeland Security] or their designees shall serve ex officio with nonvoting
25	privileges. Nonlegislative citizen members of the Board shall be citizens of the Commonwealth.
26	B. Ex officio members of the Board shall serve terms coincident with their terms of office.
27	Appointments to fill vacancies, other than by expiration of a term, shall be for the unexpired terms.
28	Vacancies shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointments. All members may be
29	reappointed.
30	After the initial staggering of terms, nonlegislative citizen members shall be appointed for a term of
31	four years. No nonlegislative citizen member shall serve more than two consecutive four-year terms. The
32	remainder of any term to which a member is appointed to fill a vacancy shall not constitute a term in
33	determining the member's eligibility for reappointment.
34	C. The Board shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from among its membership. A majority of
35	the members shall constitute a quorum. The meetings of the Board shall be held at the call of the
36	chairman or whenever the majority of the members so request.
37	§ 2.2-2493. Compensation; expenses.
38	Members of the Board shall receive no compensation for their services but shall be reimbursed for
39	all reasonable and necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties as provided in
40	§§ 2.2-2813 and 2.2-2825.
41	§ 2.2-2494. Powers and duties of the Board.
42	The Board shall have the following powers and duties:
43	1. Advise the Governor regarding the development of economic, professional, cultural, educational,
44	and governmental links between the Commonwealth of Virginia and the African American community in
45	Virginia;
46	2. Undertake studies, sponsor symposiums, conduct research, and prepare factual reports in order to
47	gather information to formulate and present recommendations to the Governor relative to issues of
48	concern and importance to the African American community in the Commonwealth;
49	3. Advise the Governor as needed regarding any statutory, regulatory, or other issues of importance
50	to the African American community in the Commonwealth;
51	4. Apply for, accept, and expend gifts, grants, or donations from public, quasi-public, or private
52	sources, including any matching funds as may be designated in an appropriation act, to enable it to
53	better carry out its objectives; and
54	5. Submit an annual report to the Governor and the General Assembly for publication as a report
55	document as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated Systems for the
56	processing of legislative documents and reports. The chairman shall submit to the Governor and the
57	General Assembly an annual executive summary of the interim activity and work of the Board no later
58	than the first day of each regular session of the General Assembly. The executive summary shall be

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- 59 submitted as a report document as provided in the procedures of the Division of Legislative Automated
- 60 Systems for the processing of legislative documents and reports and shall be posted on the General
- 61 Assembly's website.
- 62 § 2.2-2495. Staffing.
- 63 The Office of the Governor shall provide staff support to the Board. All agencies of the 64 Commonwealth shall provide assistance to the Board, upon request.
- 65 2. That the initial appointments of nonlegislative citizen members shall be staggered as follows: [
- 66 seven five] members for a one-year term, [six five] members for a two-year term, [five six]
- 67 members for a three-year term, and [three five] members for a four-year term.
