HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1141

Offered February 23, 2019

Amending and readopting Rules 20 and 23 of House Joint Resolution No. 606 of the 2019 Regular
 Session of the General Assembly of Virginia, relating to budget conference report, session adjournment and per diem payment.

8 RESOLVED by the House of Delegates, the Senate concurring, That Rules 20 and 23 of House Joint
9 Resolution No. 606 of the 2019 Regular Session of the General Assembly of Virginia are amended and
10 readopted as follows:

Rule 20. Any conference committee on the Budget Bill shall complete its deliberations and make the 11 report of such conference available to the General Assembly as soon as practicable. In accordance with 12 House Rule 75(b) and Senate Rule 39(a), neither house shall receive, consider, or vote on any Budget 13 Bill that is in conference unless it has been agreed to in writing by a majority of conferees from each 14 house. Neither house shall consider such conference report earlier than 48 24 hours after receipt, unless 15 both houses respectively determine to proceed earlier by a vote of two-thirds of the members voting in 16 each house. No engrossment of the Budget Bill shall be required in either house, and any conference on 17 the Budget Bill shall consider, as the basis of its deliberations, the Budget Bill as recommended by the 18 Governor and introduced in the House and the amendments thereto proposed by each house. A report 19 20 shall be issued concurrently with the report of the conference committee that identifies the following by item number, narrative description, and dollar amount: (i) any nonstate agency appropriation, (ii) any 21 22 item in the conference report that was not included in a general appropriation bill as passed by either 23 the House or the Senate, and (iii) any item that represents legislation that failed in either house during 24 the regular or a special session.

Rule 23. This session of the General Assembly shall be extended beyond the 30-day period
provided in Section 6 of Article IV of the Constitution of Virginia and shall adjourn sine die no later
than Saturday Sunday, February 23 24, 2019. During such extension, members of the General Assembly
shall receive session per diem; however, session per diem shall not be allowed for legislative assistants.
