10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 18.2-308.5:1 as follows:
12	§ 18.2-308.5:1. Manufacture, sale, transfer, or possession of trigger activators designed to increase
13	rate of fire of firearms prohibited; penalty.
14	A. It is unlawful for any person to manufacture, import, sell, offer for sale, possess, transfer, or
15	transport in the Commonwealth a trigger activator, including a trigger crank or a bump-fire device, that
16	is designed to increase the rate of fire of a semiautomatic rifle but does not convert the semiautomatic
17	rifle into a machine gun.
18	B. A violation of this section is punishable as a Class 1 misdemeanor.
19 20	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
20	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4 of the Code of Virginia, the estimated amount of the
21	necessary appropriation is \$0 for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities and
22 23	cannot be determined for periods of commitment to the custody of the Department of Juvenile
