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9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 54.1-2910.3:1 as follows:
11	§ 54.1-2910.3:1. Medicaid recipients; treatment involving prescription of opioids; payment.
12	[A.] No provider licensed pursuant to this chapter shall request or require a patient who is a
13	recipient of medical assistance services pursuant to the state plan for medical assistance and who is a
14	recipient of health care services involving (i) the prescription of an opioid for the management of pain
15	or (ii) the prescription of buprenorphine-containing products, methadone, or other opioid replacements
16	approved for the treatment of opioid addiction by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration for
17	medication-assisted treatment of opioid addiction to pay costs associated with the provision of such
18	service out-of-pocket, unless such provider has received a rejection of prior authorization, a rejection of
19	a submitted claim, or a written denial of reimbursement for such service from the Department of
20	Medical Assistance Services [or its contractor]. Documentation of such rejection shall be included in
21	the patient's medical record.
22	[B. Every provider who does not accept payment from the Department of Medical Assistance
23	Services for health care services and provides health care services described in subsection A to a
24	patient who is a recipient of medical assistance services pursuant to the state plan for medical
25	assistance shall provide notice to such patient that (i) the Commonwealth's program of medical
26	assistance services covers the health care services described in subsection A and the Department of

Medical Assistance Services will pay for such health care services and (ii) the provider does not 27 28

participate in the Commonwealth's program of medical assistance and will not accept payment from the Department of Medical Assistance Services for such health care services. Such notice and the patient's **2**9 30 acknowledgment of such notice shall be documented in the patient's medical record.]

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
