10	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 4 of Chapter 7 of Title 18.2 a
11	section numbered 18.2-287.5 as follows:
13	§ 18.2-287.5. Reporting lost or stolen firearms; civil penalty.
14	A. Any person who lawfully possesses a firearm that is lost or stolen from such person shall report
15	the loss or theft to any local law-enforcement agency or the Department of State Police within 24 hours
16	after such person discovers the loss or theft or is informed by a person with personal knowledge of the
17	loss or theft. The law-enforcement agency shall enter such report information into the National Crime
18	Information Center (NCIC) maintained by the Federal Bureau of Investigation. The provisions of this
19	subsection shall not apply to the loss or theft of an antique firearm as defined in § 18.2-308.2:2.
20	B. A violation of this section is punishable, for a first offense, by a civil penalty of \$50 and, for any
21	subsequent offense, by a civil penalty of not less than \$100 or more than \$250, which shall be paid into
22	the state treasury.
22	C No person who in good faith reports a firearm last or stolen shall be held ariminally or civilly

C. No person who, in good faith, reports a firearm lost or stolen shall be held criminally or civilly 23 24 25 liable for any damages for acts or omissions resulting from the loss or theft. This subsection shall not apply to any person who makes a report in violation of § 18.2-461.
