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VIRGINIA ACTS OF ASSEMBLY - CHAPTER

An Act to amend and reenact §§ 2.2-4001, 2.2-4101, and 2.2-4102 of the Code of Virginia, relating to 2 3 the Registrar of Regulations.

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Approved

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. That §§ 2.2-4001, 2.2-4101, and 2.2-4102 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as 8 follows:

§ 2.2-4001. Definitions.

As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:

11 "Agency" means any authority, instrumentality, officer, board or other unit of the state government 12 empowered by the basic laws to make regulations or decide cases.

'Agency action" means either an agency's regulation or case decision or both, any violation, 13 compliance, or noncompliance with which could be a basis for the imposition of injunctive orders, penal 14 15 or civil sanctions of any kind, or the grant or denial of relief or of a license, right, or benefit by any agency or court. 16

"Basic law" or "basic laws" means provisions of the Constitution and statutes of the Commonwealth 17 18 authorizing an agency to make regulations or decide cases or containing procedural requirements 19 therefor.

20 "Case" or "case decision" means any agency proceeding or determination that, under laws or 21 regulations at the time, a named party as a matter of past or present fact, or of threatened or 22 contemplated private action, either is, is not, or may or may not be (i) in violation of such law or 23 regulation or (ii) in compliance with any existing requirement for obtaining or retaining a license or 24 other right or benefit. 25

"Guidance document" means the same as that term is defined in § 2.2-4101.

26 "Hearing" means agency processes other than those informational or factual inquiries of an informal nature provided in §§ 2.2-4007.01 and 2.2-4019 and includes only (i) opportunity for private parties to 27 submit factual proofs in formal proceedings as provided in § 2.2-4009 in connection with the making of 28 29 regulations or (ii) a similar right of private parties or requirement of public agencies as provided in 30 § 2.2-4020 in connection with case decisions.

"Hearing officer" means an attorney selected from a list maintained by the Executive Secretary of the 31 32 Supreme Court in accordance with § 2.2-4024. 33

"Public assistance and social services programs" means those programs specified in § 63.2-100.

"Registrar" means the Registrar of Regulations appointed employed as provided in § 2.2-4102.

35 "Rule" or "regulation" means any statement of general application, having the force of law, affecting the rights or conduct of any person, adopted by an agency in accordance with the authority conferred on 36 37 it by applicable basic laws.

38 'Subordinate" means (i) one or more but less than a quorum of the members of a board constituting 39 an agency, (ii) one or more of its staff members or employees, or (iii) any other person or persons 40 designated by the agency to act in its behalf.

41 "Virginia Register of Regulations" means the publication issued under the provisions of Article 6 42 (§ 2.2-4031 et seq.).

43 "Virginia Regulatory Town Hall" means the website operated by the Department of Planning and 44 Budget, which has online public comment forums and displays information about regulatory actions under consideration in the Commonwealth and sends this information to registered public users. 45

§ 2.2-4101. Definitions.

47 As used in this chapter, unless the context requires a different meaning:

"Agency" means any authority, instrumentality, officer, board, or other unit of the government of the **48** 49 Commonwealth with express or implied authority to issue regulations other than the General Assembly, 50 courts, municipal corporations, counties, other local or regional governmental authorities including sanitary or other districts and joint state-federal, interstate or intermunicipal authorities, the Virginia 51 Resources Authority, the Virginia Code Commission with respect to minor changes made under the 52 53 provisions of § 30-150, and educational institutions operated by the Commonwealth with respect to 54 regulations that pertain to (i) their academic affairs; (ii) the selection, tenure, promotion and disciplining 55 of faculty and employees; (iii) the selection of students; and (iv) rules of conduct and disciplining of 56 students.

"Virginia Administrative Code" means the codified publication of regulations under the provisions of 57 58 Chapter 15 (§ 30-145 et seq.) of Title 30.

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"Commission" means the Virginia Code Commission. "Guidance document" means any document developed by a state agency or staff that provides 60 61 information or guidance of general applicability to the staff or public to interpret or implement statutes or the agency's rules or regulations, excluding agency minutes or documents that pertain only to the internal management of agencies. Nothing in this definition shall be construed or interpreted to expand 62 63 the identification or release of any document otherwise protected by law. 64 65

"Registrar" means the Registrar of Regulations appointed employed as provided in § 2.2-4102.

"Rule" or "regulation" means any statement of general application, having the force of law, affecting 66 67 the rights or conduct of any person, promulgated by an agency in accordance with the authority 68 conferred on it by applicable basic laws.

"Virginia Register of Regulations" means the publication issued under the provisions of Article 6 (§ 2.2-4031 et seq.) of the Administrative Process Act (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.). 69 70

§ 2.2-4102. Registrar of Regulations; publications. 71

72 The Commission shall engage or appoint on a contract, part-time, or annual basis Division of 73 Legislative Services shall employ a professionally experienced or trained Registrar of Regulations. Under the direction of the Commission or the Director of the Division of Legislative Services, the Registrar 74 shall, at a suitable place to be designated by the Commission, perform the duties required by this 75 chapter or assigned by the Commission or the Director of the Division of Legislative Services in 76 77 accordance with Chapter 40 (§ 2.2-4000 et seq.), this chapter, or Chapter 15 (§ 30-145 et seq.) of Title 78 30. The Commission shall as necessary also (i) appoint clerical or other personnel if any, (ii) arrange by 79 contract or otherwise for the necessary facilities and services, and (iii) provide for the compilation and publication of the Virginia Register of Regulations and the Virginia Administrative Code pursuant to 80 81 §§ 2.2-4031 and 30-146.
