6 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:

7 1. That § 2.2-2101 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:

8 § 2.2-2101. Prohibition against service by legislators on boards, commissions, and councils 9 within the executive branch; exceptions.

10 Members of the General Assembly shall be ineligible to serve on boards, commissions, and councils within the executive branch of state government who are responsible for administering programs 11 established by the General Assembly. Such prohibition shall not extend to boards, commissions, and 12 13 councils engaged solely in policy studies or commemorative activities. If any law directs the appointment of any member of the General Assembly to a board, commission, or council in the 14 15 executive branch of state government that is responsible for administering programs established by the General Assembly, such portion of such law shall be void, and the Governor shall appoint another 16 17 person from the Commonwealth at large to fill such a position.
