6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**

7 **1. That § 2.2-2101 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**

8 **§ 2.2-2101. Prohibition against service by legislators on boards, commissions, and councils**  
 9 **within the executive branch; exceptions.**

10 Members of the General Assembly shall be ineligible to serve on boards, commissions, and councils  
 11 within the executive branch of state government who are responsible for administering programs  
 12 established by the General Assembly. Such prohibition shall not extend to boards, commissions, and  
 13 councils engaged solely in policy studies or commemorative activities. If any law directs the  
 14 appointment of any member of the General Assembly to a board, commission, or council in the  
 15 executive branch of state government that is responsible for administering programs established by the  
 16 General Assembly, such portion of such law shall be void, and the Governor shall appoint another  
 17 person from the Commonwealth at large to fill such a position.

18 The provisions of this section shall not apply to members of the Board for Branch Pilots, who shall  
 19 be appointed as provided for in § 54.1-901; to members of the Board of Trustees of the Southwest  
 20 Virginia Higher Education Center, who shall be appointed as provided for in § 23.1-3126; to members  
 21 of the Board of Trustees of the Southern Virginia Higher Education Center, who shall be appointed as  
 22 provided for in § 23.1-3121; to members of the Board of Directors of the New College Institute, who  
 23 shall be appointed as provided for in § 23.1-3112; to members of the Advisory Board on Teacher  
 24 Education and Licensure, who shall be appointed as provided for in § 22.1-305.2; to members of the  
 25 Virginia Interagency Coordinating Council, who shall be appointed as provided for in § 2.2-5204; to  
 26 members of the Board of Veterans Services, who shall be appointed as provided for in § 2.2-2452; to  
 27 members appointed to the Board of Trustees of the Roanoke Higher Education Authority pursuant to  
 28 § 23.1-3117; to members of the Board of Trustees of the Online Virginia Network Authority, who shall  
 29 be appointed as provided in § 23.1-3136; to members of the Virginia Geographic Information Network  
 30 Advisory Board, who shall be appointed as provided for in § 2.2-2423; ~~to members of the Standards of~~  
 31 ~~Learning Innovation Committee, who shall be appointed as provided for in § 22.1-253.13:10;~~ to  
 32 members of the Board of Visitors of the Virginia School for the Deaf and the Blind, who shall be  
 33 appointed as provided for in § 22.1-346.2; to members of the Substance Abuse Services Council, who  
 34 shall be appointed as provided for in § 2.2-2696; to members of the Criminal Justice Services Board,  
 35 who shall be appointed as provided in § 9.1-108; to members of the State Executive Council for  
 36 Children's Services, who shall be appointed as provided in § 2.2-2648; to members of the Virginia Board  
 37 of Workforce Development, who shall be appointed as provided for in § 2.2-2471; to members of the  
 38 Volunteer Firefighters' and Rescue Squad Workers' Service Award Fund Board, who shall be appointed  
 39 as provided for in § 51.1-1201; to members of the Secure and Resilient Commonwealth Panel, who shall  
 40 be appointed as provided for in § 2.2-222.3; to members of the Forensic Science Board, who shall be  
 41 appointed as provided for in § 9.1-1109; to members of the Southwest Virginia Cultural Heritage  
 42 Foundation, who shall be appointed as provided in § 2.2-2735; to members of the Virginia Growth and  
 43 Opportunity Board, who shall be appointed as provided in § 2.2-2485; or to members of the Henrietta  
 44 Lacks Commission, who shall be appointed as provided in § 2.2-2538.
