4. Title: Medical Assistance Services, Department of; payment for certain services to hospice patients

- **5. Summary:** The proposed legislation directs the Department of Medical Assistance Services to implement a process for direct payment of nursing facility or ICF/MR services for hospice patients receiving services in a nursing facility or ICF/MR if such patient would be eligible for medical assistance for nursing facility or ICF/MR services had he not elected to receive hospice care. The bill provides that payments made to a nursing facility or ICF/MR shall be the full amount that would be paid to the nursing facility or ICF/MR if the individual was not receiving hospice services, and shall not reflect any discount to such rates.
- **6. Budget Amendment Necessary**: No. The introduced budget includes funding sufficient to cover the anticipated cost of this bill.
