4. Title: Absentee voting; certain absentee voters permitted to vote after close of absentee voting location.

5. Summary: Provides that an applicant who is in line to cast his ballot when the office of the general registrar or location being used for in-person absentee voting closes shall be permitted to cast his absentee ballot that day.
