Summary:** Authorizes vehicles used for hauling trees, logs, or any other forest products to be equipped with flashing, blinking, or alternating amber warning lights approved by the Superintendent of State Police, provided that the amber lights are mounted or installed so as to be visible from behind the vehicle.
