4. Title: License plates, special; VIRGINIA LOVES TEACHERS

5. Summary: This bill authorizes the issuance of special license plates for supporters of teachers in the Commonwealth bearing the legend VIRGINIA LOVES TEACHERS.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) anticipates incurring the upfront cost for materials to produce a new plate series. However, these costs will be recouped through the sales of prepaid applications for the special plate, required by Virginia Code § 46.2-725, and the \$10 special license plate fee that is to be set aside for the Department's use.

This legislation will not result in a significant expenditure increase for the DMV. The staff hours required to implement the legislation can be accomplished during the normal work schedules for DMV employees, given current workloads. DMV would be able to absorb this cost within its existing resources assuming other legislative proposals with fiscal impacts to DMV are not passed. DMV's current fiscal outlook precludes funding the cumulative burden of implementing the programming and staffing requirements of multiple pieces of legislation without improved revenue streams.
