Summary: Provides that if an association is located in a locality classifying home-based child care services as an accessory or ancillary residential use under the locality's zoning ordinance, the provision of home-based child care services in a personal residence shall be deemed a residential use unless (i) expressly prohibited or restricted by the declaration or (ii restricted by the association's bylaws or rules. The bill is a recommendation of the Virginia Housing Commission.
