4. Title: Extended Employment Services; removes eligibility of individuals with a significant disability

5. Summary: The proposed legislation removes the eligibility of individuals with a significant disability to receive Extended Employment Services (EES). Under current law, Extended Employment Services are available to individuals with a significant disability or a most significant disability.

8. Fiscal Implications: No fiscal impact is expected as it is assumed that EES spending will not decrease, but instead shift entirely to those individuals with a most significant disability. The amount of funding available for EES is set by Appropriation Act language.
