**3. Committee:** Agriculture, Chesapeake and Natural Resources

**4. Title:** Oyster planting grounds; municipal dredging projects; compensation.

**5. Summary:** Extends the duration of an exception, for municipal dredging, to the right of a person to lease oyster planting grounds, and establishes a procedure for determining compensation to such a leaseholder when his grounds are disturbed by such a dredging project. The bill extends from 2019 to 2035 the sunset date for an exception to the leaseholder's right that allows certain municipal dredging projects to take place in the Lynnhaven River.
