**4. Title:** Richmond, City of; amending charter, runoff elections

Summary:** Provides, for any runoff election for mayor after a general election or runoff election to fill a vacancy for the office of mayor after a special election, that the procedures and deadlines for voter registration and absentee ballots be the same as those prescribed for general elections in Chapters 4, 4.1, and 7 of Title 24.2, Code of Virginia for general elections.
