4. Title: Department of General Services; disposition of surplus materials; veteran-owned small business and veterans service organizations.

Summary: This bill provides that the Department of General Services shall permit surplus materials to be sold to (i) small businesses certified by the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity that are (a) military spouse-owned or (b) veteran-owned and (ii) veterans service organizations.
