Summary:** Requires an entity's website to be in compliance with Chapter 9 of Title 51.5, Code of Virginia, regarding its accessibility by persons with vision or hearing impairment, until such time that the federal government adopts standards governing website accessibility, if it meets the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines 2.0 Level AA as developed by the Web Accessibility Initiative. An entity is defined as a bank, trust company, savings institution, or credit union.
