3. Committee: Courts of Justice

4. Title: Custody and visitation orders; history of family abuse; law-enforcement officers.

5. Summary: Provides that in cases in which a history of family abuse has been considered, at the request of either party, the court may order a law enforcement officer to be present at the exchange of a child pursuant to a custody or visitation order. The bill provides that nothing in this Code section shall preclude a court from ordering that the exchange of a child shall take place at an appropriate meeting place, including a police station.
